

**TOWN OF NEEPAWA
BY-LAW NO. 2527**

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF NEEPAWA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BY-LAW NO. 2316 (Derelict Vehicle By-Law).

WHEREAS it is desirous to amend the definition of "derelict vehicle" to correspond with the definition set out in section 294 (1) of The Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Neepawa in session duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Definition (b) "Derelict Vehicle" of By-Law No. 2316 be and is hereby repealed and the following substituted;
 - b. "Derelict Vehicle means a vehicle if it is not a new and unused vehicle, and if
 - i. it is not in operating condition;
 - ii. it does not have attached thereto, and exposed thereon, one or more number plates issued under The Highway Traffic Act for the current registration year under that Act;
 - iii. it is kept in the open; and
 - iv. the owner thereof either has abandoned it or is keeping it primarily for the purposes of salvaging or selling parts there from or for the eventual sale thereof as scrap metal; and a derelict vehicle also includes the body or chassis of a used motor vehicle all or some of the parts of which have been removed, and to which clauses (ii), (iii) and (iv) apply."
