

TOWN OF NEEPAWA

BY-LAW # 3079

Being a by-law of the Town of Neepawa to authorize prepayment on current taxes and to establish rates to be applied for arrears.

WHEREAS Section 344 of The Municipal Act states that a council may allow a discount for the prepayment of taxes on or before a date specified in the by-law.

AND WHEREAS Section 345 of The Municipal Act states that a council may by by-law allow taxes to be paid in installments.

AND WHEREAS Section 346 (2) states that a council may by by-law set a rate at which penalties may be imposed in respect of tax arrears.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a By-Law of the Town of Neepawa as follows:

1. That the municipality will accept prepayment of current taxes for 2010 at a discount rate up to the first day of September as follows:
 - January – 3.5%
 - February – 2.5%
 - March – 1.5%
 - April – 0.5%
 - May to September – Par
2. That taxpayers wishing to prepay their taxes for 2010 be permitted to pay up to 95% of the previous years total taxes, less any credit or discount allowed.
3. That the municipality will impose a penalty of 1 ¼ % per month on taxes in arrears, as well as on taxes outstanding as of October 1, 2010.
4. That By-Law No. 3068 be and the same is hereby repealed.
