



RECYCLE IT'S WORTH IT!

The Town of Neepawa recycling is picked up EVERY MONDAY MORNING. Residents should have their recyclables placed in the same location as they do their refuse, prior to 7:00 a.m. on the morning of pickup.

Recyclables must be stored in a blue box, or bagged in clear or see through bags.

Paper & glass must be kept separate from all other recyclable materials.

GLASS PICKUP WILL OCCUR ON THE 1st TUESDAY of EACH MONTH

RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

PAPER: All newsprint, magazines, flyers, writing paper, envelopes, catalogues, paper egg cartons, phone books, calendars, books (hard & soft cover), paper bags, cardboard boxes and cereal boxes. (No dirty pizza boxes or other oil contaminated products). Please bag paper products separate from other recyclable material.

PLASTIC: Pop bottles, milk jugs, margarine tubs and lids, ice cream pails, bags, shampoo bottles and all other containers with the recyclable symbol. (Rinsed clean with lids removed)

ALUMINIM/TIN: Pop cans, soup and vegetable tins, coffee cans, etc. (Rinsed clean, labels can be left on)

GLASS: All colors of bottles and jars. No light bulbs. Glass must be separate from other recyclable materials. (Rinsed clean with lids removed)

There is also a drop-off bin for recyclables located at TAC Ventures on Airport Road or at Evergreen Environmental Technologies (located 9 miles West of Neepawa and 2 ½ miles South on Cordova Road, #466)

Your recyclables must be put out by 7:00 a.m. on your pick-up day.

NON RECYCLABLE ITEMS

TIRES/PESTICIDE CONTAINERS/METALS/HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE: (paint cans, etc.) Accepted only at Evergreen Environmental Technologies.

USED OIL/OIL FILTRES/OIL CONTAINERS: Can be dropped off at the Eco-Center located at Provost Signs on Airport Road. Phone 476-5548 for info and drop off times.

BULKY HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION: Bulky household wastes will be picked up the first Tuesday of each month. Arrangements must be made at the Town Office with payment of \$30 per pickup in order for pickup.

COMPOST ITEMS:

GRASS/LEAVES/BRANCHES/GARDEN MATERIAL

Note that compost material left out with/as garbage will NOT be picked up. All compost material must be taken to the compost site, on the North side of Riverside Cemetery on Hurrell Road. Please dump compost material from bags at the appropriate location when leaving at the compost site. Spring and fall clean-up programs will be offered with dates to be announced prior to each program.

The Town is only charged on the amount of garbage delivered to the landfill site. Therefore, the more recycling we do, the less we have to pay - saving you TAX DOLLARS! Thanks for recycling!
