The Town of Neepawa will soon be using CodeRED, a highspeed mass notification system to keep you safe in the event of an emergency or to provide general information that you need to know with short notice. The system allows the Town to deliver messages to you via phone call to your landline or mobile device and through text and email.

There are two types of calls/messages you may receive – Emergency Notifications as well as General Notifications – examples on left.

A CodeRED Emergency message will have a caller ID of 1-866-419-5000.

A CodeRED General message will have a caller ID of 1-855-969-4636.

We suggest you program both numbers in your cell phone as a “new contact” and use “CodeRED Emergency” and “CodeRED General” as the contact names.

There is also a **free CodeRED Mobile Alert app** for iPhone & Android subscribers, which will allow you to stay informed no matter where you are! Also, when traveling, your CodeRED Mobile Alert app will notify you of any emergency situation if you are near a community using the CodeRED system.

further information about how to sign up.**

If your contact information is not in the database, you will not receive alerts in an emergency.
