



Open Air Fires By-Law (No. 3055):

(NOTE – FOR MORE DETAIL PLEASE SEE THE ENTIRE BY-LAW – THESE ARE HIGHLIGHTS ONLY AND NOT INTENDED TO BE INCLUSIVE OF ALL RULES)



ACCEPTABLE FIRE PITS:

- Pit to have enclosed sides made from brick, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal or other non-combustible materials;
 - 5 feet clearance from buildings, property lines or other combustible material;
 - Height of pit not to exceed 20 inches from surrounding grade to top of pit opening;
- Spark arrestor mesh screen, constructed of expanded metal or equivalent is to be used to cover the fire pit opening;

HIGHLIGHTS OF BY-LAW:

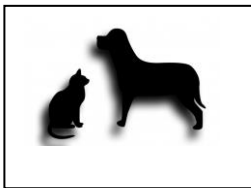
- Do not leave fire unattended;
- Do not set a fire in windy conditions;
- If smoke causes unreasonable interference of another person’s property, the fire shall be extinguished immediately;
- All outdoor burning receptacles shall be separated from grass or other vegetation by at least 16 inches, by means of earth, sand, gravel or other non-combustible medium;
 - Burning barrels or other similar device are prohibited;
- **Do not burn debris including (but not limited to) non-wooden material, tires, oil, garden refuse, household refuse.**

Failure to abide by the provisions of any Town by-law is an offence which is subject to applicable fines.



Animal Control By-Law (No. 3001):

RESTRICTIONS ON DOMESTIC PETS:

- Maximum of two (2) dogs and three (3) cats - over the age of 3 months;

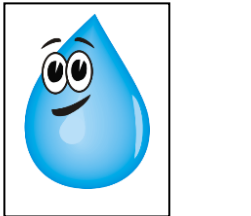
HIGHLIGHTS OF RESPONSIBILITY REGARDING PETS:

- ALL dogs and cats MUST be issued a License from the Town Administration Office;
 - Dogs or Cats may not run at large;
 - Dogs may not bark or howl to disturb the quiet of any person;
- Owners must clean up after pets with respect to defecation on public or private property.
