1. Call to Order

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Neepawa do now open this Public Hearing to hear representation to Subdivision 4437-16-7679 (Town of Neepawa – CN Property) in respect of the Creation of New Public Roads.

2. Subdivision 4437-16-7679

- Under the provisions of *The Planning Act*, there is a requirement to hold a public hearing on a proposed subdivision if the subdivision will result in the creation of new public roads.
- Notification of the hearing was provided in accordance with the terms of *The Planning Act*.
- No official objections were registered, however concerns were noted by Mr. Tim Brown, owner of Dairy Queen, regarding the limited access locations off of PTH #5.
- Administration confirmed that recent discussions with Manitoba Infrastructure were necessary to ensure compliance with provincial legislation which sets out specific criteria for the location and distances between allowable access points onto provincial highways. In reference to this particular subdivision only two access points will be permitted under the authority of Manitoba Infrastructure per *The Highway Traffic Act* and associated regulations.
