2. Road Closing By-Law 3175-17 - Close Portion of Cameron Street

Chief Administrative Officer Sychyshyn provided details by-law 3175-17 & the public hearing. This hearing to premise a by-law that would replace By-Law 3130 passed by Council in May 2016 (Subdivision 4437-14-7293). At the stage of subdivision completion, the proponent attempted to register the road plan, which was rejected by the Property Registry due to issues with mines and minerals. The plan was re-drawn to satisfy the requirement of the Property Registry and the public hearing and new by-law were required as part of the process outlined in legislation to support and give effect to the registration.
