SNOW Reminders!

Businesses: By 10am after each snowfall, all snow & ice must be removed from your sidewalk.

Business & Residential: You are NOT permitted to pile snow on streets/sidewalks. You will be charged for the costs associated with the removal of your snow piles.

NO PARKING ON STREET WHEN SNOWPLOWS ARE OUT!

If you wish to build/enlarge a driveway, you MUST get an appropriate permit and instructions prior to starting construction – please contact our office!



DO NOT put any grease or oil down your drains or your toilets!

Pour all grease into an old can/jar/jug, seal it and place in your garbage! Wipe all dishes, pots, pans etc before rinsing or washing.



RECYCLING Reminders:

- * Cell Phone Recycling Box at the Town Office!
- * Don't forget there is a recycling depot at the Public Works Shop (124 Gill Drive)!
- * Light bulbs, Paint, etc can be taken to Home Hardware, Coop or Evergreen.
- * Hazardous waste, electronics, used clothing, mattresses to Evergreen.

GARBAGE Reminders:



- * Must be at curb by 7am and be visible and accessible.
- * Bags larger than 1m X 1m or more than 40 lbs will be NOT be picked up.
- * Three (3) garbage bag limit per week, you may purchase a \$2 Bag Tag at Town Office for excess garbage.
- * Dumpsters and carts are NOT for public use – violators may be charged with an offence.
- * Bulk waste pick ups, call 204-483-3986 - For large items such as furniture; all costs are your responsibility.

Did you know...?!

1. It is illegal to cross a solid yellow line to park on the opposite side of the street! (even in winter when covered by snow!)
2. The area around your Water Meter is to be kept free/clear of all debris & obstructions and be accessible at all times.
3. Water Meters are NOT to be tampered with, any damage will result in replacement costs at your expense.
4. Reduce your speed by our schools in accordance with the law – keep our children safe, SLOW DOWN and be aware!
5. You are not permitted to park on a road facing the opposite direction of traffic – it is dangerous and illegal.
6. Community Notice – January 1st, price change goes in effect for the HandiVan. One-way-\$4.00; Pre-paid book of 10-\$35.00.
