*FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE*

As of today, the total number of cases in Manitoba sits at 96.

Of those, 4 are in hospital, one is in intensive care, one has passed away, and two have recovered.

\*IMPORTANT → Public gatherings - limited to **no more than 10 people** at any indoor/outdoor place or premise. This includes places of worship, gatherings and family events such as weddings and funerals.

In addition to all previously imposed restrictions, under *The Public Health Act*, **effective 12:01 a.m. Wednesday April 1<sup>st</sup>:**

- All restaurants and other commercial facilities that serve food are prohibited from serving food to customers in their premises. Delivery service and take-out service can continue if adherence to social distancing strategies can be achieved.
- All businesses not deemed as critical must close between April 1 and April 14. This closure order does not prevent these businesses from operating on a remote basis.
