POLICY

The Town of Neepawa operates the Neepawa Swimming Pool, providing a variety of aquatics programs to residents of the Town of Neepawa and the surrounding areas.

PROCEDURE

1. All fees for passes, programs and lessons shall be approved by resolution of Council on an as-needed basis.
2. All fees, programs and lessons are subject to change.

Regular Swim Passes:

1. Entitles patrons to unlimited public swim usage only.
2. Does not include specialized program offerings such as Aqua Fit, Parents & Tots, Lap Swim, Workout Programs, or any other specialized offering.
3. Available passes include:
 - a. Children's Pass – patrons aged 5-6
 - b. Student Pass – patrons aged 7-18
 - c. Adult Pass - patrons aged 19 – 55
 - d. Senior Pass – patrons aged 55+
 - e. Family Pass – Patrons of an immediate family unit only (i.e. does not include grandparents). Limited to a maximum of 2 adults and 5 children – no exceptions.
 - f. Weekend Pass
 - g. Day Pass

Programs:

1. Available on a pay-per-class, pay per-month, or pay per program basis.
2. Programs available:
 - a. Aqua Fit – water exercise class, includes instruction
 - b. Lap Swim – independent lap swimming
 - c. Family Swim – Parents/adults & children as a family unit together, per household
 - d. Parents & Tots – Parents and tots together. Tots defined as a patron up to the age of 4 years only. Fee is per household.

Swimming Lessons:

1. Available in group, private group or private individual basis. On-line registration and payment.
2. Lessons available (subject to availability):
 - a. Pre-School Lessons
 - b. Levels 1-10
 - c. Bronze Medallion and Bronze Cross
3. Full lesson refunds will be considered ONLY if:
 - a. notice is given PRIOR to the start of the third class in the session and the pool supervisor on duty has been made aware of withdrawal and refund.
 - b. NO exceptions will be made.

Pool Rentals:

1. Group rentals subject to availability, as outlined on pool calendar
2. Available in one or two hour time blocks.
3. Up to 25 patrons, based on fees set by Resolution
4. Additional patrons, based on fees set by Resolution
5. Lifeguards will be provided
6. For Group rentals and Day Care rentals, you must:
 - a. Have one adult in attendance for every six children 8 and under;
 - b. Have one adult in attendance for every ten children 9 and over;
 - c. For Day Care rentals – the adults must be in the water with the children.
