## **POLICY**

The Town of Neepawa operates the Neepawa Swimming Pool (Facility) and has implemented Facility Rules for the safety of our patrons and staff.

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Facility Rules are as per LS-020 Appendix A which may be updated from time to time.
- 2. All Town Staff/Lifeguards are to adhere to and enforce all Facility Rules;
- 3. Facility Rules shall be posted at the Facility front entrance and any other high traffic area deemed necessary;
- 4. All patrons are expected to follow all Facility Rules;
- 5. Town Staff/Lifeguards reserve the right to ask patrons to leave the facility, should the Facility Rules not be followed.



- 1. All children 4 years of age and under will be admitted free of charge when accompanied by a parent/guardian who has a season pass or paid admission.
- 2. All children 4 years of age and under MUST be accompanied IN THE WATER by a responsible parent/guardian AT ALL times.
- 3. All children ages 5 to 8 years of age MUST be accompanied and supervised by a responsible parent/guardian at all times.
- 4. All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire.
- 5. No t-shirts, cutoffs, or shorts permitted as swimwear. Bathing suits only.
- 6. All long hair must be tied back.
- 7. All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- 8. To enter the deep end of the pool, all swimmers must be able to complete two widths of the pool, under the supervision of a lifeguard. There will be no exceptions.
- 9. No smoking within the facility area or near the entrance doors (outside fenced area only).
- 10. Food/drink will be permitted in the grass areas only no glass containers.
- 11. If the water temperature is below 70F, the Session Supervisor has the right to cancel lessons and/or public swim/programs.
- 12. The pool, staff and Town of Neepawa accept no responsibility for any lost or stolen property.
- 13. In the event of an emergency:
  - a. Two or more whistle blows Clear the Pool Immediately
  - b. Staff will direct patrons accordingly, as per LS-010 Storms and Emergencies.

Lifeguards reserve the right to ask patrons to leave the facility for failure to abide by any written or stated Facility Rules
