

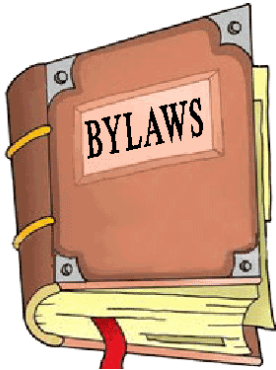
BY-LAW REMINDERS!

Traffic By-Law (No. 3155-16)

- No campers or trailers to be parked on street for more than 72 hrs without a Permit – may be subject to towing and/or fines.

Zoning By-Law (2650) & Private Driveway Approaches By-Law (3127):

- Off Street Parking, in all residential zones, to be limited to side yards or rear yards;
- In instances where side yards are not sufficient width, and no rear access – then NOT MORE than 2 private passenger vehicles permitted and **must be located on an existing or newly approved approach/driveway.**
- Where a new approach/driveway is needed, prior approval is required from the Town and Planning District.
- Parking of boats, trailers, campers, motor homes or any like uses are only permitted where adequate surfacing exists or has been approved by the Town of Neepawa/Planning District.



Open Air Fires By-Law (No. 3055):

ACCEPTABLE FIRE PITS:

- Enclosed sides made from brick, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal or other non-combustible materials;
- 5 feet clearance from buildings, property lines or other combustible material;
- Height of pit not to exceed 20 inches from surrounding grade to top of pit opening;
- Mesh screen, constructed of expanded metal or equivalent is to cover the fire pit opening;

HIGHLIGHTS OF BY-LAW:

- Do not leave fire unattended;
- Do not set a fire in windy conditions;
- If smoke causes unreasonable interference of another person's property, the fire shall be extinguished immediately;
- All outdoor burning receptacles shall be separated from grass or other vegetation by at least 16 inches, by means of earth, sand, gravel or other non-combustible medium;
- Burning barrels or other similar devices are prohibited;
- **Do not burn debris including (but not limited to) non-wooden material, tires, oil, garden refuse, household garbage.**



Animal Control By-Law (No. 3001):



- Maximum of two (2) dogs and three (3) cats - over the age of 3 months;
- ALL dogs and cats MUST be issued a License from the Town Administration Office;
- Dogs or Cats may not run at large;
- Dogs may not bark or howl to disturb the quiet of any person;
- Owners must clean up after pets with respect to defecation on public or private property.

TOWN TIDBITS:

- All commercial cardboard boxes are to be broken down and bundled for recycling;
- Each residence is permitted three (3) bags of household garbage – Garbage includes food waste, refuse, any non-recyclable items, etc; if you exceed the 3-bag limit, you may purchase a Bag Tag from the town office (\$2 ea).
- YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO PLACE YOUR GARBAGE IN ANY COMMERCIAL GARBAGE BIN – those are private garbage bins and not for public use. Cameras are in use, you may be subject to fines.
- You are required to keep your yard/lawn in a tidy manner – please ensure grass is cut and junk is removed to avoid penalties under the Property Standards By-Law No. 3166-16.

RESIDENTIAL GREASE – DO NOT PUT GREASE OR OIL DOWN YOUR DRAINS, GREASE MUST BE PLACED INTO A CONTAINER (OLD CAN/JAR/JUG) AND SEALED, THEN DISPOSED OF IN YOUR GARBAGE.

NOTE: If grease has been found to be originating from your house, you may be subject to legal liability, possible insurance claims and lawsuits.

Do NOT put any grease or oil down your drains or toilets.

Sewer Blockage Formation



The start of a blocked pipe begins when grease and solids collect on the top and sides of the pipe interior.



The build-up increases over time when grease and other debris are washed down the drain.



Excessive accumulation will restrict the flow of wastewater and can result in a sanitary sewer overflow.

Commercial Businesses - NO commercial grease is permitted in the garbage. It may be taken directly to Evergreen Environmental or you may make arrangements with Rothesay.
