The public health orders issued on March 30 have been extended to April 28, 2020. As a result, the following remains in effect:

- Restrictions on public gatherings to 10 or fewer people
- > The closure of non-essential businesses, and
- Enforcement of social distancing measures by businesses and services that remain open including ensuring a two-metre distance is kept between people in the facility of premises.
