Updates on some of the more "fun & visual" things we have been doing around Town!

Multi Use

• Perimeter trail is 75% complete, this will be connected to The Great Trail.

Trail Park:

- Two-unit washroom complete and fully functioning.
- Trail Builders will be on site beginning construction July 27th.
- 15 wooden features complete and on site ready for use (at own risk).
- Installed a 10-foot diameter culvert feature.

Riverbend:

- \$25,000 Grant received for the installation of solar panels to power our Pool building.
- 20 beautiful new custom fire pots have been delivered to Riverbend Campground.

Fire Dept:

• 16 SCBA's (Breathing Apparatus) purchased for the safety of our Fire Crew.

- **Around Town:** 15 new Christmas decorations to replace aging, tattered decorations.
 - The Asphalt Patcher has been making its way around all our streets.
 - Microsealing will take place on some streets in the coming months.
 - 450 metres of water & storm drain pipe installed.
 - 6 catch basins & 3 man holes installed.
 - 280 metres of sidewalk renewal/construction to be completed this summer.
