A WEDGIE WORTHY WATERSLIDE IS COMING!

We are excited to announce that a waterslide design for the outdoor swimming pool has been selected! This beauty has 86 feet of fun with a 360 degree curve and a 270 degree reverse curve. The slide itself will be "Viper Red" with "Snow White" metal supports & stairs. The slide will not enter the pool, but into a separate run out area. If there are no delays in manufacturing & installation, we hope to have the slide rideable by Summer 2023.



NEW SIGNAGE HITTING THE TRAILS

For the last couple of years the Trans Canada Trail was known as "The Great Trail". After much confusion, the trail has reverted back to being the Trans Canada Trail and has received a new look. Check out their new logo, on all the wayfinding signs along the Neepawa-Langford Trail.

We have received a \$1380 grant from the Assiniboine North Parent Child Care Coalition to create a Story Book Trail in Neepawa!

This trail will be constructed around the Canada 150 path at The Flats in Spring 2022.

The main goal of the storybook trail is to get families out walking the trail and encouraging them to read the book as they walk along.

Grants are a good way to increase opportunities in Neepawa without costing the taxpayers.

Here is a list of the grants we have applied for in the last month, fingers crossed that we are selected!

Applied for:

- Trans Canada Trail - Seasonal Clean-up Grant - \$2,000 to help groom trails in the winter and fix gravel steps on North Side of the Trail by Commerce Street.
- Westoba Inspire Fund - \$5,000 to help cover costs of waterslide
- MB Coalition for Safer Waters - \$2,000 to train swimming pool lifeguards and instructors for 2022.
- Community Futures Westman - \$3,000 for 2 Floor Curling Systems
- Celebrate Canada - \$5,000 for Canada Day Fireworks

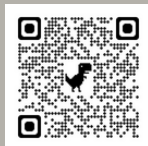
