THE TOWN OF NEEPAWA BY-LAW NO. 3223-23

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF NEEPAWA TO PRESCRIBE A FEE CHARGEABLE FOR TAX CERTIFICATES.

WHEREAS Subsection 341 (1) of Division I of Part II of *The Municipal Act* provides as follows:

341(1) On request and payment of a fee prescribed by by-law, a designated officer must issue a tax certificate.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and advisable to prescribe a fee chargeable for issuing tax certificates,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a By-Law of the Town of Neepawa duly assembled as follows:

- 1. THAT the fee chargeable for a tax certificate shall be forty dollars (\$40.00) with respect to the land described in each entry in the tax assessment roll for which a tax certificate is furnished.
- 2. THAT the Designated Officer who must issue the tax certificates shall be the Chief Administrative Officer or other such designated officer as assigned by the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Neepawa.
- 3. That By-Law #3102 is hereby repealed.
- 4. This By-law shall come into force, and take effect on its passing.
