YOU MUST NOTIFY OUR OFFICE

You need a FINAL Water Meter Reading!

As soon as possible, but AT LEAST two (2) working days prior to the change of ownership/occupancy, the occupant must:

- Call or email our office to notify us.
- Provide your forwarding mailing address for your final bill.
- Advise the new owner/occupant to contact us with their name and mailing address.

Until we are notified appropriately, you remain responsible for the water billing and any usage.

WATER BILL REMINDER

As a homeowner in Neepawa, you will receive a water bill within the first 10 days of the month following the end of the billing quarter.

If you have not received your bill within this timeframe, please contact the office. Bills have been known to get lost in the mail, or delivered to your "junk mail".

You are still responsible for paying your bill on time.

Please be proactive and avoid overdue account charges by calling the office to check on the status of your bill/account balance.

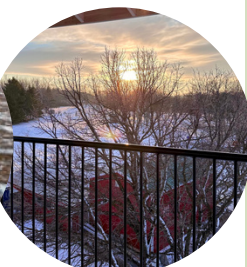

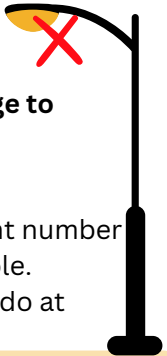
