PUBLIC NOTICE PARKING WITH THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC



Residents & visitors are reminded that all vehicles parked on Town streets must be positioned to face the same direction as the flow of traffic (parallel to the curb or edge of the roadway).

Parking on the wrong side of the road is illegal and violates By-Law 3155-16.

Vehicles parked incorrectly may be towed at the owner's expense!

EMERGENCY VEHICLES

When emergency vehicles approach with active lights and sirens, drivers must slow down, yield the right-of-way and pull over to the right to allow the emergency vehicle to pass.



When approaching a stopped emergency vehicle with their lights flashing, drivers must slow down. If the speed limit is 80 km/h or higher, reduce speed to 60 km/h. If the limit is below 80 km/h, reduce speed to 40 km/h.
