Candle Safety

Candles can be a serious fire hazard if not used properly. Here are some ways you can reduce health and safety risks when burning candles;

- Use flameless candles whenever possible
- Use sturdy candle holders that won't tip easily
 - Do not burn candles on or near anything that can catch fire
 - Extinguish all candles before going to bed or leaving the room
 - Cut candle wicks short to prevent high flames when burning



Winter Road Safety

Our winters can be dangerous with the ice and snow, here are a few tips to stay safe;

- Clear all snow and ice from car windows and roof
- Drive at safe speeds
- Get winter tires on your vehicle
- Always have an emergency kit in your vehicle
 - Wear driving gloves to ensure warm hands
 - Wear sunglasses - even though it's cold outside, the sun can still be bright.



EMERGENCY VEHICLES

If you ever see an ambulance, firetruck, police car or another emergency vehicle – slow down, and pull over to allow for the emergency vehicle to get to the emergency.

QUICK MEAL PREP OF THE QUARTER

Back of the Pantry Rice Bowl

- 1 small carton of Ground Pork/Beef/Turkey
- 2 Cups of Rice
- 1 Can of Beans
- 1 Can of mixed veggies
- Sauce of your choosing (suggest: Sweet Thai Chili)



1. Cook Ground pork, beef, or turkey on pan. When it's fully cooked add some water and taco seasoning and stir.
2. Cook Rice. While rice is cooking put beans, corn, and peas in microwave with sauce of your choosing or just water.
3. Once everything is finished cooking mix all ingredients together and enjoy your meal!

Traffic By-Law No. 3155-16

REMINDER

Parking in "Snow Routes" is prohibited from 1am to 6am, November 1 to April 30 to allow for snow clearing operations. Some of the designate Snow Routes are as follows, and parking is prohibited overnight:

- * Mountain Ave,
- * Hamilton Street (btwn Brown & Second Ave),
- * Hospital Street,
- * First Ave (btwn Main & Brydon),
- * Brown Ave (btwn Main & Davidson),
- * Mill St (btwn First & Mountain),
- * Ellen St (btwn First & Brown),
- * Davidson St (btwn Mountain & Brown),
- * Plus other Streets throughout Town that have signage.

It is your responsibility to:

- * Be aware of all Snow Routes and parking restrictions;
- * You MUST find alternate, legal, parking arrangements;
- * Always check for signs on any street as it may be a Snow Route;

Vehicles may be towed (at owners expense) and a fine may be issued. It causes safety issues for the snow plow operators, other vehicular traffic, pedestrians, and the snow will not get cleared at a later date.
