RAVENS MAY BE ANNOYING, BUT THEY ARE A PROTECTED SPECIES!

Ravens are attracted to: bird baths, water fountains, bird feeders, garbage, long grass etc.

How to deter them from coming into your yard:

- Ensure garbage carts are covered and no loose garbage is left lying around
- Cover wood piles
- Keep your grass short in length
- Clean out eavestroughs

Other suggestions:

They do not like shiny objects – hang cheap aluminum pans from trees. The sun will reflect off them and deter the birds. Ravens do not like the feel of baking soda – you can sprinkle it where they frequently perch.



SUMMER FIRE SAFETY

Summer is the perfect time to sit around that campfire and roast a snack or two... but are you doing it properly?

In order to have a SAFE & LEGAL fire, your firepit must be CSA approved. Important Reminders:

- 1) Fires are NEVER to be left unattended
- 2) Always have water available to extinguish the fire
- 3) Do not have a campfire in windy conditions
- 4) Ensure your approved pit has an appropriate screen
- 5) Be aware of fire bans!
- 6) Know and understand Open Air Fires By-Law No. 3055

Please be courteous and make sure the smoke from your fire isn't blowing into your neighbors' yards.

NLS builds on the skills, knowledge and values that the LSS teaches in its Pre-Bronze and Bronze Medal awards to develop the practical skills and knowledge required by lifeguards. Recognized as the standard measure of lifeguard performance in Canada, NLS education is designed to develop a sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgment, and a mature and responsible attitude toward the role of the lifeguard.

Summer Evening Snack



1. Purchase peaches, brie, a baguette, and your favourite balsamic (ex: peach balsamic)
2. Slice the baguette at a slight angle into 1 inch slices.
3. Slice peaches and brie thinly
4. Place brie and peaches onto baguette slices.
5. Put in oven or air fryer at 375 degrees Fahrenheit for approximately 4 minutes (just to toast the baguette and slightly melt brie)
6. Drizzle balsamic on the top & Enjoy!
