Potato Leek Soup

Ingredients

- 2 lbs of Yellow Potatoes
- 4 large Leeks
- 3 tbsp Butter
- 3 cloves of Garlic
- 2 Fresh Thyme sprigs
- 1 cup Milk or Cream
- 1 tbsp Lemon Juice
- 1 tsp of Salt & Pepper
- 5 cups Vegetable Broth

- Chop the white and light green parts of the leeks. Wash well.
- Heat the butter in a large pot over medium heat. Add the leeks, salt, and several grinds of pepper and cook for 8 to 10 minutes, stirring occasionally, or until the leeks are soft.
- Add the potatoes, garlic, broth, and thyme and simmer for 20 minutes, or until the potatoes are very soft. Remove the thyme, then use an immersion blender or transfer the soup to an upright blender to blend until smooth. Return the soup to the pot and stir in the milk. Season to taste, adding the lemon juice, if desired.
- Garnish with chives and serve.

- Limit the number of people who have keys to your facility
- Hold regular training sessions to teach proper operation of the alarm
